### TRAVEL

- GPAC teams will be required to follow GPAC travel protocols, including pre-travel screening. Additionally, on site screening for GPAC unattached athletes will be mandatory before entering the facility.
- Non-Conference teams will be allowed to compete if they follow institutional travel protocols. Pre-travel screening will be required for all non-conference teams to attend Mount Marty track and field meets. (non-conference unattached athletes prohibited from competition).

### SPECTATORS

- Spectators will be allowed. This policy will be revisited if changes are made on campus or statewide to indoor capacity recommendations.
- Mount Marty will provide a live stream of events.

### MASKS / FACE COVERINGS

- Facemasks are required upon arrival to campus or competition venue.
- This includes but is not limited to restrooms, hallways, locker rooms, competition venue, team camps, etc.
- Teams (including staff and coaches) will be required to wear a mask/face covering at all times including warm ups and cool downs.
- Athletes may remove facemask during warm up, competition and cool down, but must be put back on within a reasonable amount of time after the rep is completed.
- Teams (including staff/coaches) are expected to wear face coverings anytime they leave the competition venue.

### FACILITY AVAILABILITY

- Restrooms and showers will be available. The expectation is for teams to return to the indoor track in reasonable time (no loitering).
- The rest of the building will be closed to teams (including staff and coaches).
- No loitering in hallways or any areas deemed unnecessary for the hosted competition.

### GAME DAY COVID 19 SCREENING

- Game day screening must take place within 6 hours of the event for all team personnel and be administered by a medical professional or other qualified staffs.
- Contact MMU Athletic Training staff in advance if unable to complete game day screening prior to arrival (within the 6 hour time frame).
- Officials and workers are to be screened by an MMU athletic trainer or other qualified staff.

### FAILURE TO COMPLY

- Failure to follow COVID protocols will result in a team (including staff/coaches) dismissal from meet.
